<u>Dressage tests:</u> Found on the USEA website http://useventing.com/competitions/dressage and the intro test on the USDF website https://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/2019.asp We offer a small court sand arena 20m x 40m

<u>Cross country jumps</u> will be in a grass field and some through a wooded area and introducing downhill+uphill track into a quarry with fun and inviting jumps.

Stadium phase will be in our lovely covered arena.

<u>Clothing:</u> Breeches, boots and helmet required for all phases. Medical armband and protective vest required for the jumping phase. Formal clothing and braiding optional.
